Pancleefandarpels Another Top Mare For Peter Pan

Peter Pan Stables has enjoyed great success with pacing fillies and mares. The list includes Mystical Maddy, French Panicure, Panything Goes, Pans Culottes, and now Pancleefandarpels, a new millionaire, who is in action at Yonkers Raceway Friday night.

Peter Pan Stables bred and owns Pancleefandarpels, who is the 3-1 morning line favorite in the \$38,000 Open Pace for fillies and mares. Peter Pan also bred Tomorrowpan, the morning line favorite in race 12 at Yonkers Friday, but sold her in January.

Pancleefandarpels, a daughter of Noble Ability, is coming into Friday's race off a win in the same class at Yonkers the week before and another victory could put her over \$250,000 in earnings for 2011, a year which has already seen her top \$1 million in career money-winnings. Pancleefandarpels is the second mare Peter Pan has owned that has topped \$1 mil in earnings, the other being the accomplished Mystical Maddy, with French Panicure very close at \$997,902.

In addition to becoming a millionairess, Pancleefandarpels lowered her lifetime mark this year—at the age of seven—to 1:50.1 (on July 1 in an overnight at Mohawk) and has put together a 8-10-6 record in 34 starts.

“Pancleefandarpels was a gorgeous yearling,” said Peter Pan Stable principal Bob Glazer via email. “Chris Marino originally broke and trained her and she was a stakes winner on the New York Sire Stakes circuit, finishing second in the final at age three to another Noble Ability homebred of mine named The Isle Of Pan.”

In 2009 Pancleefandarpels won the Blue Chip Matchmaker Final and this year she raced mostly on the Woodbine-Mohawk circuit for trainer Bob McIntosh before returning to the Erv Miller Stable for her action at Yonkers.

Glazer said Pancleefandarpels is the “best individual” out of his mare Teamtress p,4, 1:51.4 (\$226,837), who he bought as a 3 year old and saw win the Shady Daisy at Freehold late in her sophomore season. Teamtress's other foals include Seamstresforthe pan p, 1:52.4f (\$431,957) and Pansai Yamamoto p,3, 1:52.2f (\$66,394), who is competing in the \$660,000 Valedictory final at Woodbine on Monday, Dec. 26.

Glazer said he sold Tomorrowpan because she was small as a yearling and was a little small for him to retain as a broodmare since he still has her dam, Disneypan, and a sister. As for the future of Pancleefandarpels as a mom, “She will be a great cross with either The Panderosa or No Pan Intended,” said Glazer.
